## School Picture and Yearbook Information

**Purchasing School Pictures:** To purchase a school photo for your child, you will go online to [mylifetouch.com](http://mylifetouch.com). Once there, you should see a little graphic that looks like a two tabbed folder. You would select "Student ID" that would allow you to search for them on [mylifetouch.com](http://mylifetouch.com). First you will enter your identifying information, it should connect you to the online proof of your child's photos and show you the packages available. If you have difficulty with the process, the phone number for Lifetouch is 1-800-736-4753.

**Purchasing Senior Cap and Gown Photos:** Lifetouch is done coming to PHS for senior pictures. If your child still needs a photo or wants a retake, you can contact their studio in Bensalem, PA for an individual appointment at 800-687-9327. Proof kits are sent out about 6 weeks after the photos are taken. If you are having trouble accessing the photos after that

timeframe, please let me know. If your kiddo did not get a cap and gown photo and doesn't want one, but still wants to be in the yearbook, I am happy to take a quick photo in my office. Just let me know.

**Purchasing Yearbooks:** The Prince Yearbook is still available for advanced copies online at [www.yearbookordercenter.com](http://www.yearbookordercenter.com) using school code 4078. Yearbooks are \$99 each. Seniors who are eligible for free or reduced lunch can email me and I will add a yearbook for them free of charge. All students in grades 9-11 eligible for free or reduced lunch can purchase their yearbook online for half off on the website above. Students can see me for additional financial concerns. Yearbooks do tend to sell out once we distribute them. The best way to make sure your child gets one is to preorder online. Price goes up in January. This is the best time to order!

**Senior Parent Farewell Ads:** Farewells are on sale now through [www.yearbookordercenter.com](http://www.yearbookordercenter.com) using school code 4078. They provide the templates, you provide the sentiments and the photos. Farewell space normally fills up by the end of February or early March, so if you are interested please create your message as soon as you have a free moment to make sure you have a spot. The funds received from the farewell program allow us to provide free yearbooks to seniors eligible for free and reduced lunch. Your support is greatly appreciated.

It is a tuition-free, summer, residential program for high-achieving high school juniors who have an interest in STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) subjects. Currently, there are two programs: the Governor's School in the Sciences at Drew University and the Governor's School of Engineering & Technology at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey. The programs are open to students from diverse economic backgrounds who are New Jersey residents and who have completed their junior year in any public or private high school or are home-schooled.
